Program Needing to expand beyond the iconic Wanamaker Building, Incyte Corporation recently unveiled a new 154,000 square foot building at their corporate headquarters in Wilmington along Augustine Cut-Off. In addition to housing administration and clinical development employees, the new building features a community garden and a "living wall" with live plants off the main lobby.

Incyte Corporation employs more than 1,200 people in the United States, Europe, and Japan. Incyte is best known as the developer and marketer of Jakafi, which was first approved by the FDA in 2011 as a treatment for patients with intermediate or high-risk myelofibrosis, a group of rare cancers of the bone marrow. In late 2014, the FDA also approved the drug as a treatment for patients with polycythemia vera, a slow-growing blood cancer that causes a person's bone marrow to make too many red blood cells.
